

DISPOSITION OF TANGIBLE PERSONAL PROPERTY

The following is a statement of specific gifts of tangible personal property. If such assets are owned by me at my death, I direct my Executor or Trustee to carry out and make the specific bequests contained in this statement. If there is a conflict between the disposition of any item of tangible personal property made by this writing and a specific bequest of the same item in my will or trust, the provisions of the will or trust shall control the disposition of the item in question. I do not intend that this writing be a will or codicil, even if it is inadvertently executed in such a way that it appears to satisfy the legal requirements therefore, but that it serve only as the written statement or list referred to in Virginia Code § 64.1-45.1. **THIS STATEMENT OR LIST CAN BE USED ONLY FOR THE DISPOSITION OF TANGIBLE PERSONAL PROPERTY, SUCH AS FURNITURE, FURNISHINGS, SILVER, CHINA, JEWELRY, CLOTHING, ETC. IT CANNOT BE USED TO DISPOSE OF REAL ESTATE OR TO DISPOSE OF INTANGIBLE PERSONAL PROPERTY, SUCH AS CASH, STOCKS, BONDS, BANK ACCOUNTS, CERTIFICATES OF DEPOSIT, ETC.**
